Dear Patti:

Pursuant to the provisions of section 37-425, R.R.S. 1998, permission is granted to Department of Health and Human Services to take wards of the state fishing, on a group basis, for therapeutic purposes.

Any staff member or guardian who accompanies the wards of the state may assist the wards in fishing and are not required to have a valid fishing permit. Those staff or guardians that are actively fishing themselves must possess a valid fishing permit.

State statutes do not allow for a waiver of the park entry permit.

This permit, or a photocopy, must be carried by a staff member when wards of the state are fishing.

This permit expires December 31, 2016.
